MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

DEGREE –DIRECT ENTRY

At least 2 principal passes in relevant subjects obtained at A 'level at the same sitting and 5 passes obtained at O'level at the same sitting holders of Diploma in relevant fields.

DIPLOMAS

Holders of two-year relevant certificate offer O'level. Uganda advanced certificate of education with at least 1 principal pass and two subsidiaries obtained at the same sitting or equivalent.

CERTIFICATE COURSES

Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) with at least 3 passes at the same sitting. The minimum entry qualifications must meet the requirements of national curriculum in Uganda
Intake in a year (2 intakes per year) day and weekend: February and August in-service (holidays) January and August.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

Great Lakes Regional University provides accommodation services to students at a cost of 150,000 per semester. This is on first come first serve basis. There are several private Hostels around Campus where students are free to get accommodation at very affordable rates. The Office of the Dean of Students is in charge of hostels and students can also be privately arranged to take meals at the university canteen around campus at a very affordable rate of a minimum of shs.450,000 per semester.

HEALTH SERVICES

The university offers health services in the university clinic on campus. However, there are also Health Services in the neighbourhood where students can be referred to for treatment namely: Kambuga Hospital (government) , Kirima HCIII ,Katate HCIV and Bwindi Hospital (private).

ACCESS TO THE UNIVERSITY

The University is 2km from Kanungu town along Kanungu-Kihihi road. You can link to Kanungu via Rukungiri, Kabale, and the Ishasha-Kanungu newly tarmacked Road. The university can also be accessed from Congo through Ishasha and Katunguru. The university is accessible by air through Butagata Airstrip and Savannah Airfield (Kihihi) and then travel on a road to Kanungu Town Council.
